

Cookie policy

What are cookies?

Cookies are small pieces of data, stored in text files, that are retained on your computer or other device when our website is loaded in a browser. They are widely used to 'remember' a visitor and their preferences, either for a single visit (through a 'session cookie') or for multiple repeat visits (using a 'persistent cookie'). They provide a consistent and efficient experience for visitors, and perform essential functions such as allowing users to register and remain logged in. Cookies may be set by us | or by third parties, such as those who serve content or provide advertising or analytics services on the website ('third party cookies').

We use cookies for several different purposes.

Strictly Necessary: These are the cookies that are essential for our website to perform basic functions. Included are those required to allow registered users to authenticate and perform account related functions.

Performance: Performance cookies collect information on how users interact with the website including what pages are visited most, as well as other analytical data. These details are only used to improve how the website functions.

Tracking: These are set by trusted third party networks (e.g. Google Analytics) to track details such as the number of unique visitors, and pageviews to help improve the user experience.

Third Party/Embedded Content: We use some third party applications and services to enhance the experience of our website visitors. These include social media platforms such as Facebook (through the use of sharing buttons), or embedded content from YouTube or Vimeo. As a result, cookies may be set by these third parties, and used by them to track your online activity. We have no direct control over the information that is collected by these cookies.
